1. OVERVIEW

The Autom Mate Community Edition is operated by Autom Mate Corporation. Throughout the site, the terms “we”, “us” and “our” refer to Autom Mate Corporation. Autom Mate Corporation offers this the community edition, including all information, tools and services available from the community edition to you, the user, conditioned upon your acceptance of all terms, conditions, policies and notices stated here.
